◆From Mizunashiguchi

To Sandandaki 30minutes one way (1.5km)

The following sections of Sandankyo are currenty closed to traffic.

① Sandandaki Junction – Sarutobi / Nidandaki – Yokogoguchi

Access is permitted only on days when the Sarutobi Ferry is in operating.(From July 11 to through mid-September)

②Sandandaki – Shimo Mochinoki

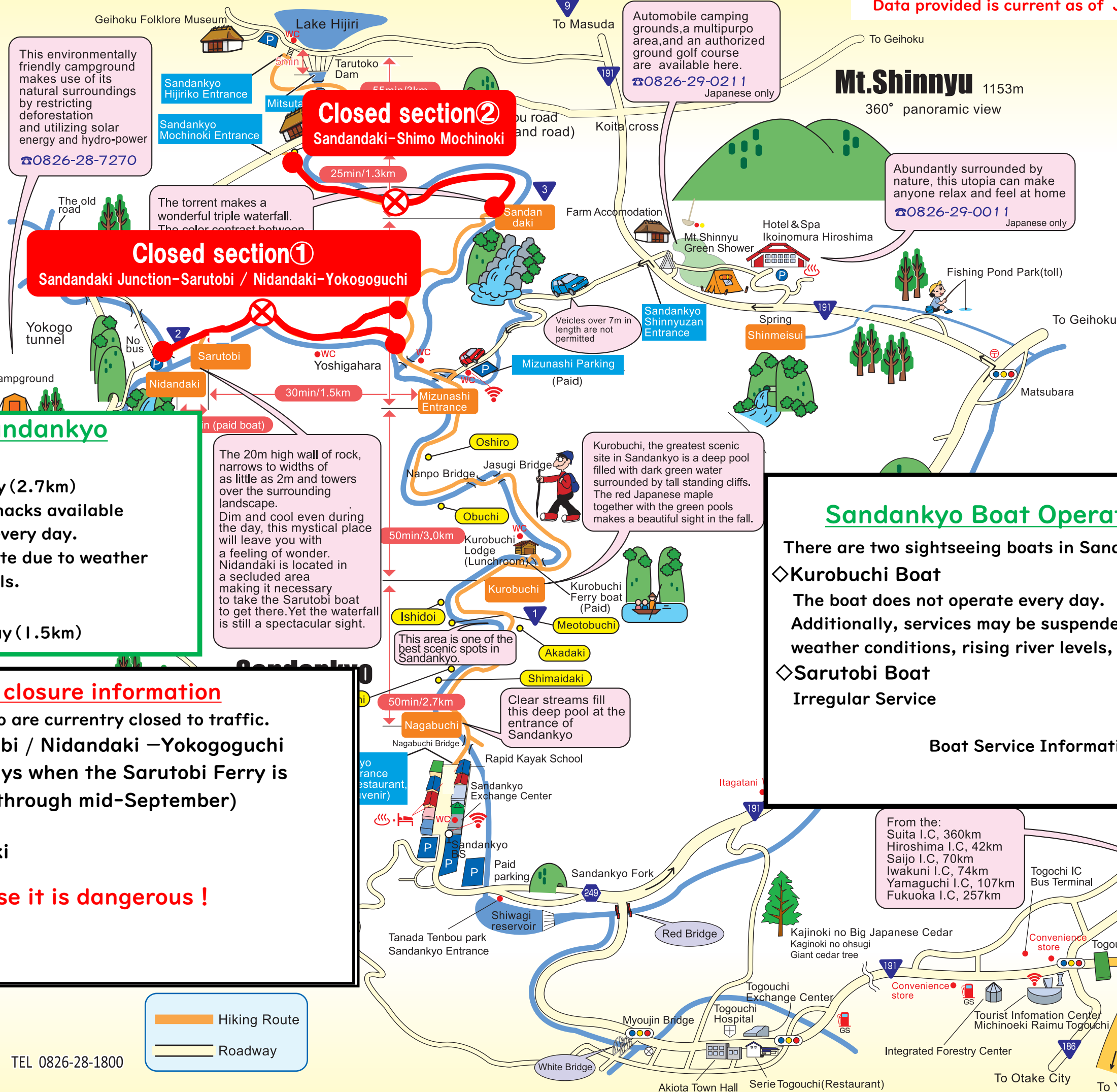
